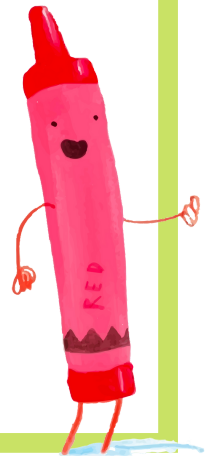

SUMMER READING COMES TO A CLOSE

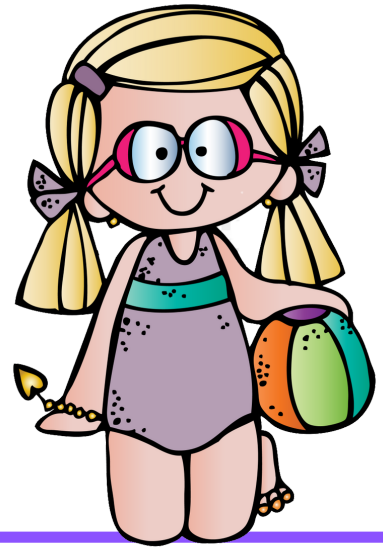
The last day to log your reading for Summer Reading Challenge is July 10. Once you have completed all reading and activities in the Beanstack app, you will receive information on the finale pool party.
