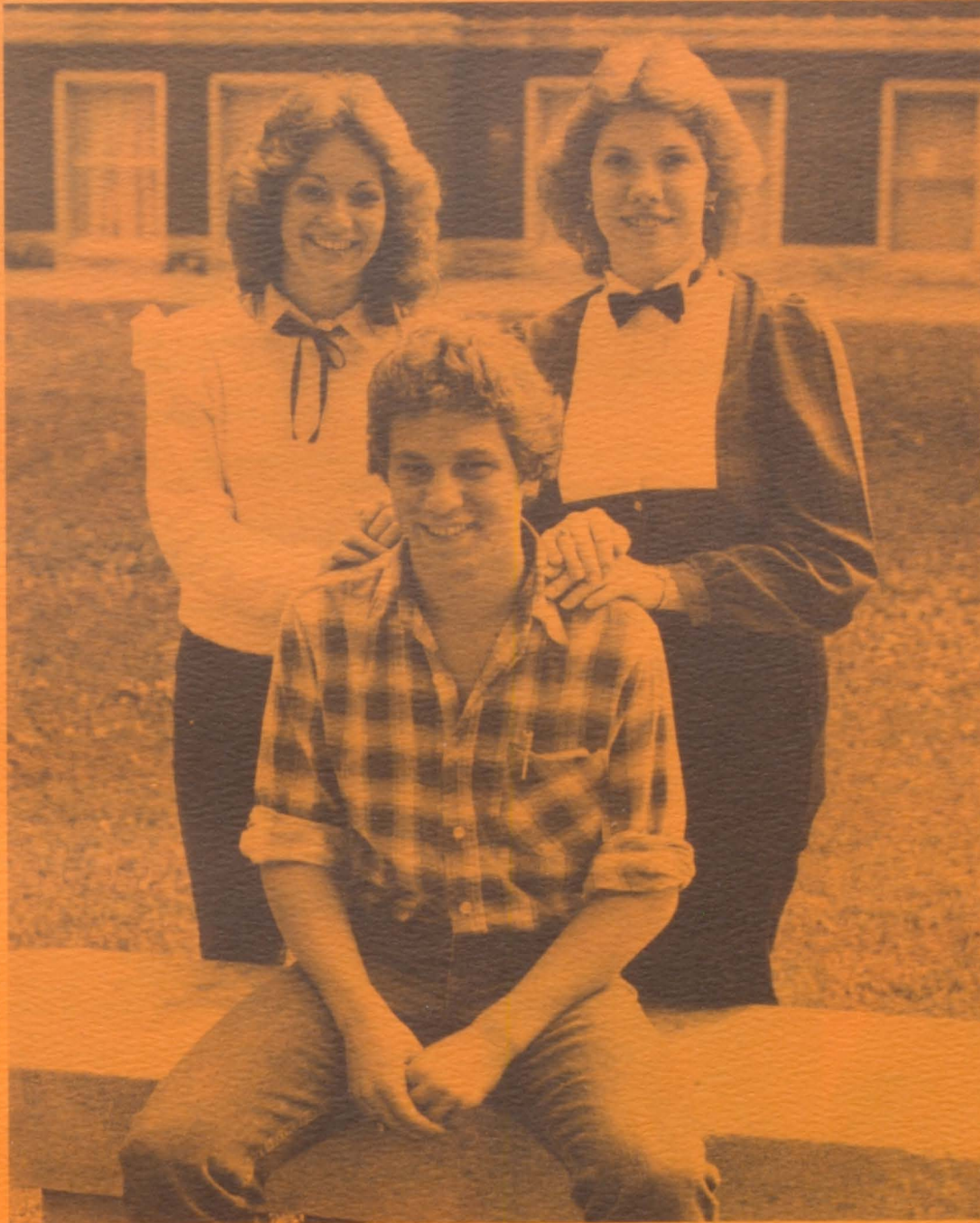
EXCHANGE STUDENT
