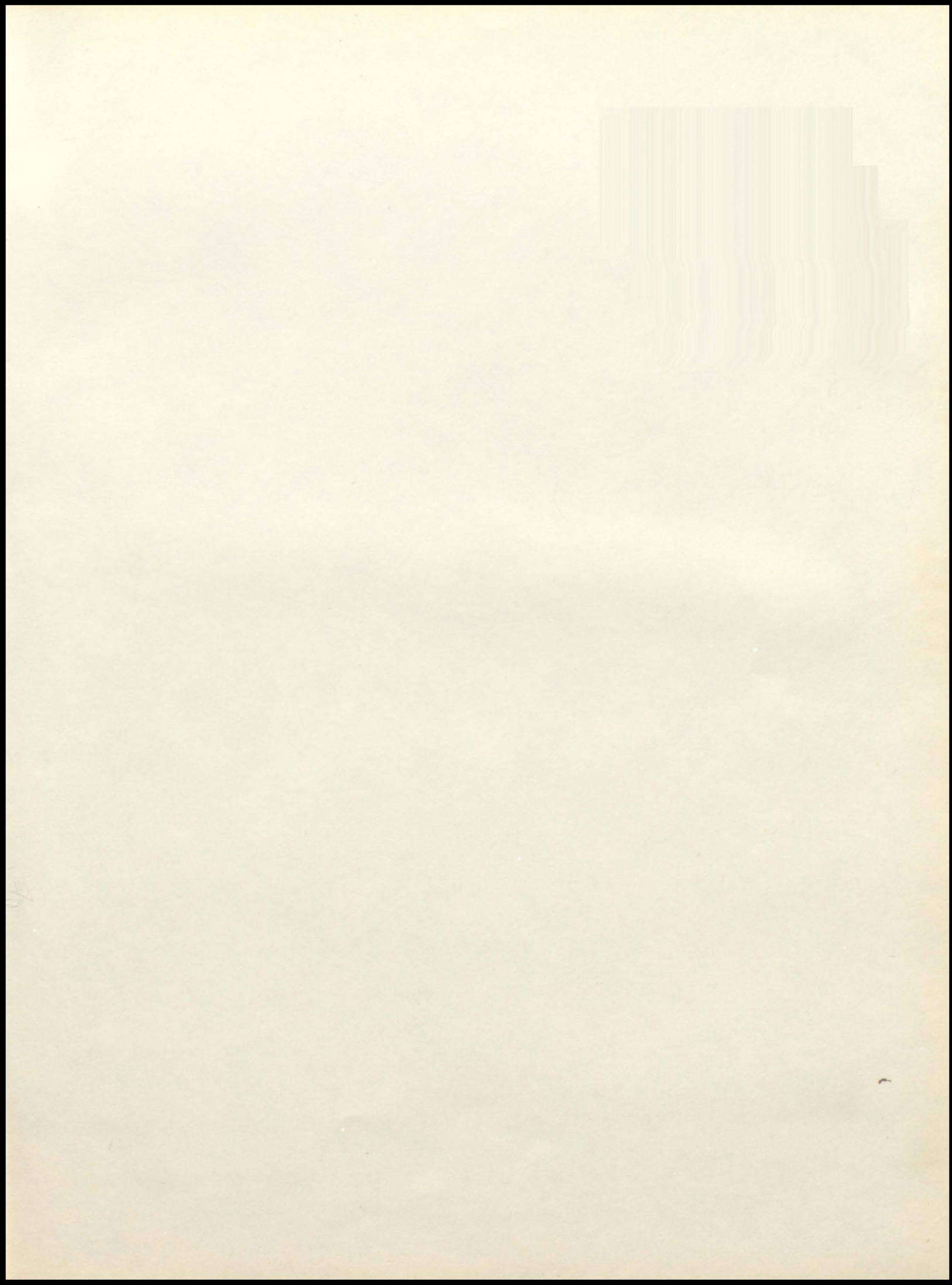


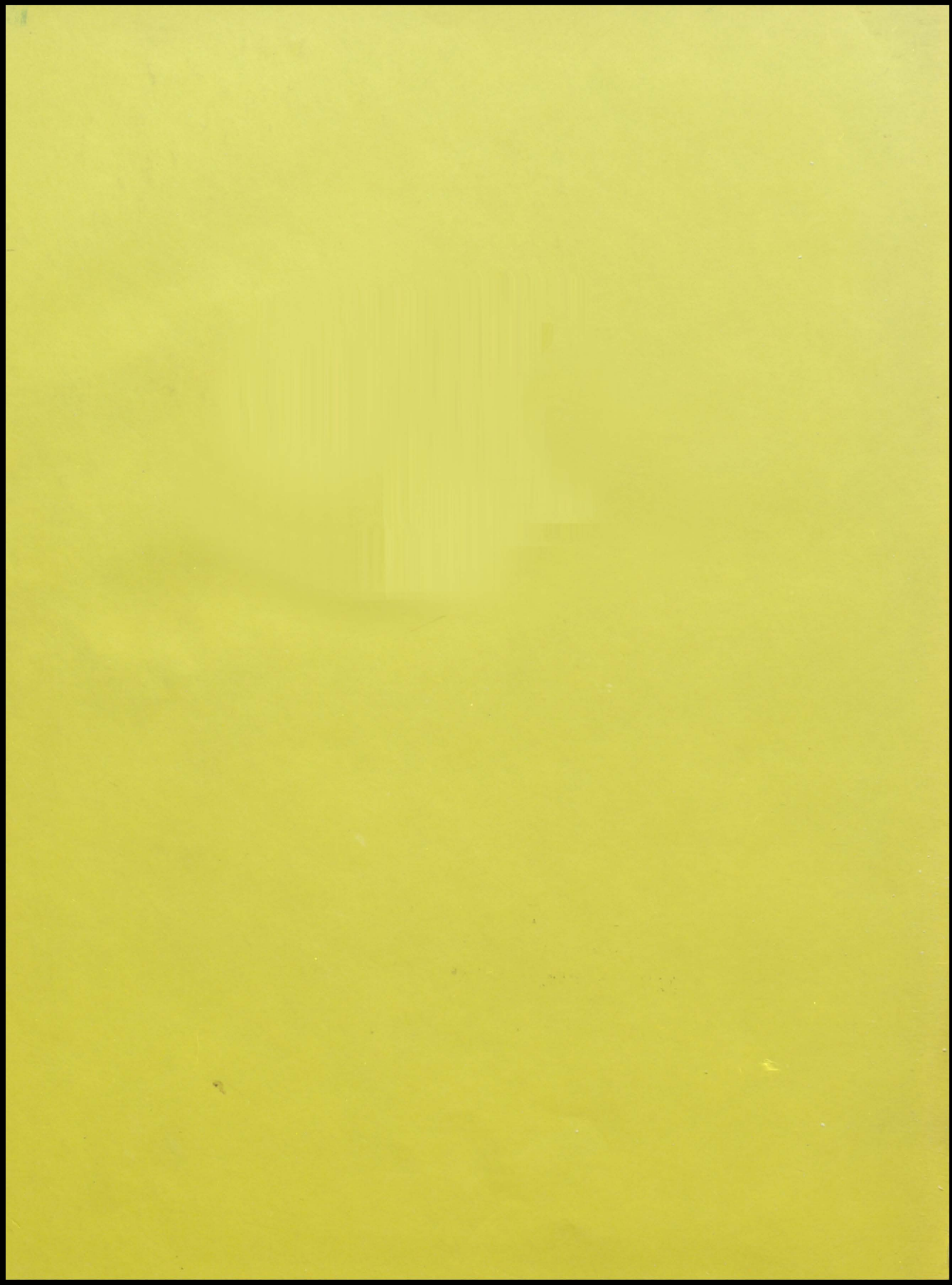














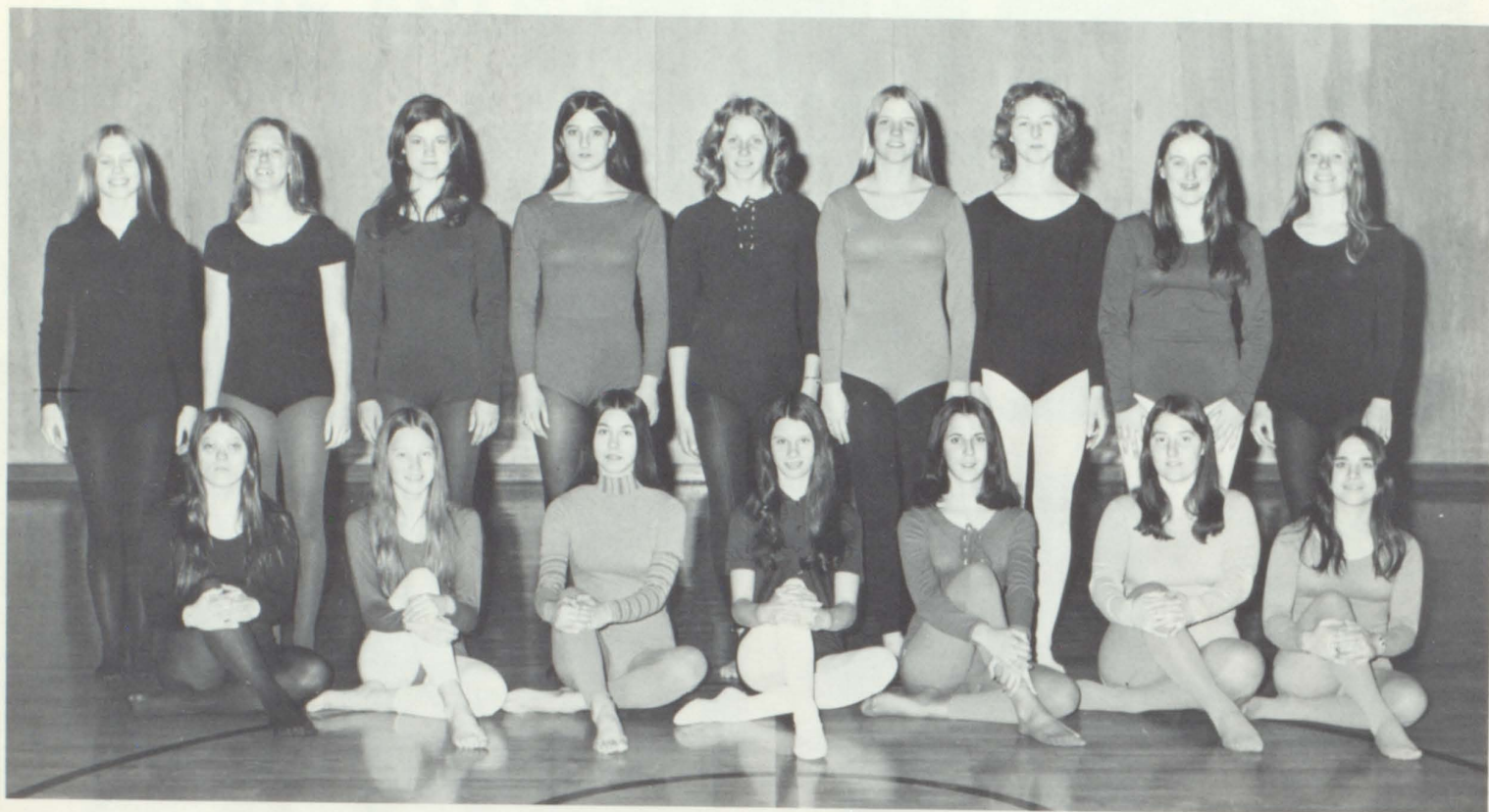
FINE ARTS FESTIVAL

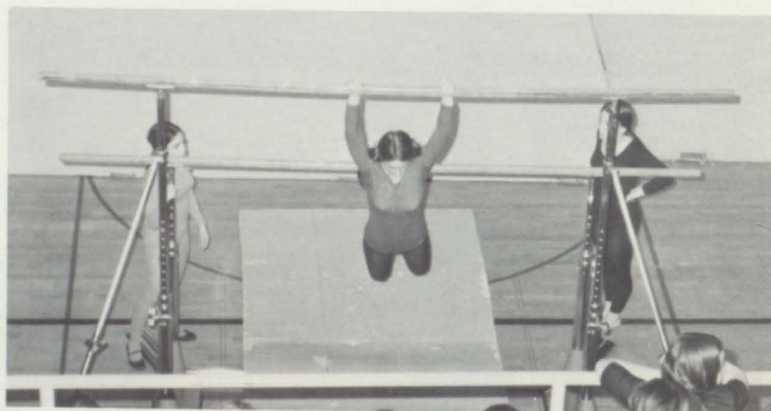

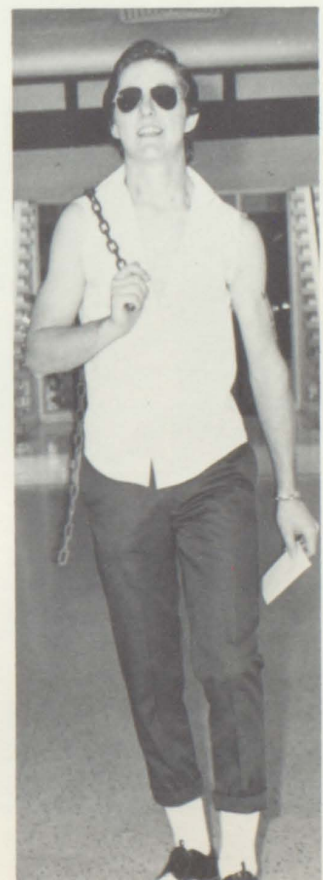

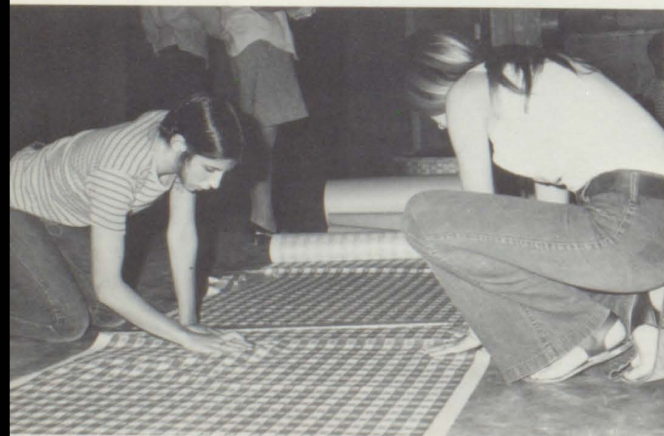
BIG SISTERS TEA

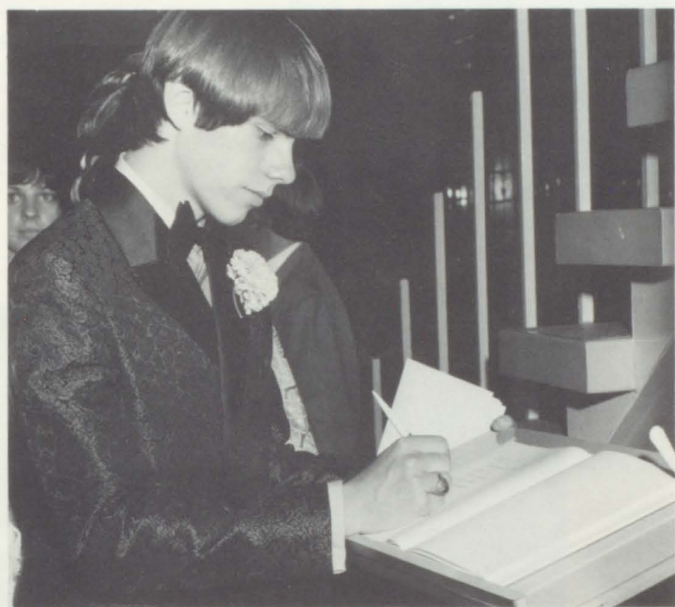

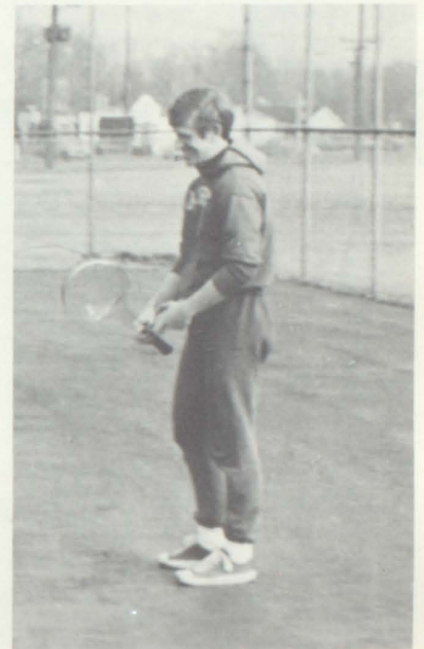

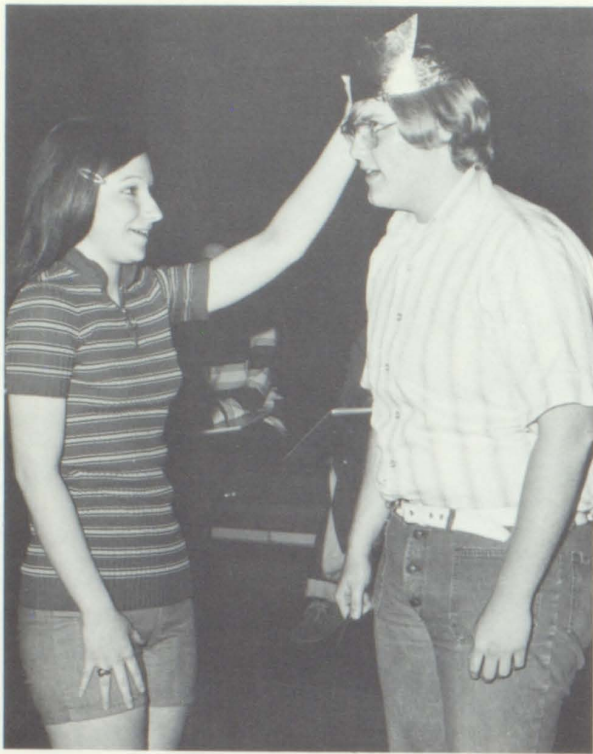

THESPIAN BANQUET



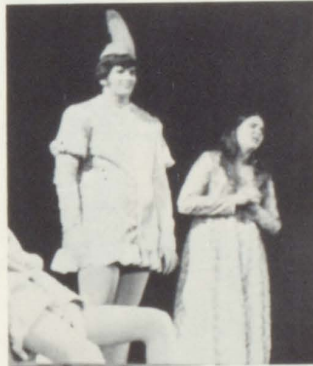

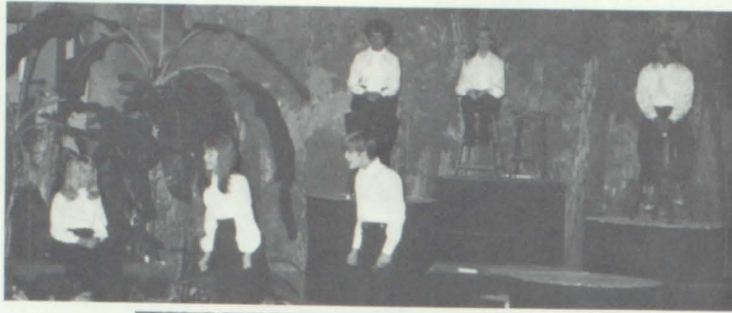

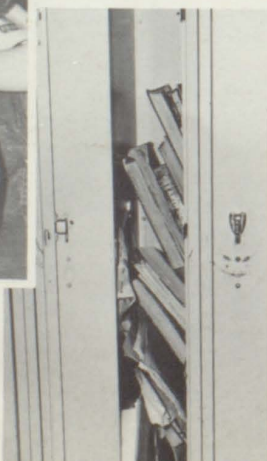
